(ii) Paper in refereed journals without impact factor - 5 Points (iii) Paper with impact factor less than 1 - 10 Points (iv) Paper with impact factor between 1 and 2 - 15 Points (v) Paper with impact factor between 2 and 5 - 20 Points (vi) Paper with impact factor between 5 and 10 - 25 Points (vii) Paper with impact factor > 10 - 30 Points

- (a) Two authors: 70% of total value of publication for each author.
- (b) More than two authors: 70% of total value of publication for the First/Principal/Corresponding author and 30% of total value of publication for each of the joint authors.

Joint Projects: Principal Investigator and Co-investigator would get 50% each.

# Career Advancement Scheme (CAS) for University Teachers

# I. Assistant Professor (Academic Level 10) to Assistant Professor (Senior Scale/Academic Level 11) Eligibility:

- 1. An Assistant Professor who has completed four years of service with a Ph.D. degree or five years of service with a M.Phil. / PG Degree in Professional Courses, such as LLM, M.Tech, M.V.Sc. and M.D., or six years of service in case of those without a Ph.D./M.Phil./ PG Degree in a Professional course and satisfies the following conditions:
- 2. Attended one Orientation course of 21 days duration on teaching methodology;
- 3. Any one of the following: Completed Refresher/ Research Methodology Course/ Workshop/ Syllabus Up-gradation Workshop/ Training Teaching-Learning-Evaluation, Technology Programmes/ Faculty Development Programmes of at least one week (5 days) duration, or taken one MOOCs course (with e- certification) or development of e-contents in four-quadrants / MOOC's course during the assessment period; and
- 4. Published one research publication in the peer-reviewed journals or UGC-listed journals during assessment period.

#### **CAS Promotion Criteria:**

## A teacher shall be promoted if;

- i) He/she gets a 'satisfactory' or 'good' grade in the annual performance assessment reports of at least three/four/five of the last four/five/six years of the assessment period as the case may be (as provided in Appendix II, Table 1), and;
- ii) The promotion is recommended by the screening-cum evaluation committee.

# II. Assistant Professor (Senior Scale/Academic Level 11) to Assistant Professor (Selection Grade/Academic Level 12)

#### **Eligibility:**

- 1. Assistant Professors who has completed five years of service in Academic Level 11/Senior Scale.
- 2. A Ph.D. Degree in the subject relevant/allied/relevant discipline.
- 3. Has done any two of the following in the last five years of Academic Level 11/Senior Scale: Completed a course / programme from amongst the categories of Refresher Courses/Research Methodology/ Workshops/ Syllabus Up-gradation Workshop/ Teaching-Learning-Evaluation/ Technology Programmes / Faculty Development Programme of at least two weeks (ten days) duration (or completed two courses of at least one week (five days) duration in lieu of every single course/programme of at least two weeks (ten days) duration), or, completed one MOOCs course in the relevant subject (with e-certification); or contribution towards the development of e-content in 4-quadrant (at least one quadrant) minimum of 10 modules of a course/contribution towards the development of at least 10 modules of MOOCs course/contribution towards conduct of a MOOCs course during the period of assessment.
- 4. Published three research papers in the peer-reviewed journals or UGC-listed journals during assessment period.

#### **CAS Promotion Criteria:**

A teacher shall be promoted if;

- 1. The teacher gets a 'satisfactory' or 'good' grade in the annual performance assessment reports of at least four of the last five years of the assessment period, (as prescribed in Appendix II, Table 1) and;
- 2. The promotion is recommended by the Screening-cum-evaluation committee.

# III. Assistant Professor (Selection Grade/Academic Level 12) to Associate Professor (Academic Level 13A)

- 1. Assistant Professor who has completed three years of service in Academic Level 12/ Selection grade.
- 2. A Ph.D Degree in the subject concerned/allied/relevant discipline.
- 3. Any one of the following during last three years: completed one course / programme from amongst the categories of Refresher Courses/ Research Methodology Workshops/Syllabus Upgradation Workshop/ Teaching-Learning-Evaluation Technology Programme/ Faculty Development Programme of at least two weeks (ten days) duration (or completed two courses of at least one week (five days) duration in lieu of every single course/programme of at least two weeks (ten days) duration); or completed one MOOCs course (with e- certification); or contribution towards the development of e-content in 4-quadrant (at least one quadrant) minimum of 10 modules of a course/contribution towards development of at least 10 modules of MOOCs course/ contribution towards conduct of a MOOCs course during the period of assessment.
- 4. A minimum of seven publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals out of which three research papers should have been published during the assessment period.
- 5. Evidence of having guided at least one Ph.D. candidate.

#### **CAS Promotion Criteria:**

A teacher shall be promoted if;

- 1. He/she gets a 'satisfactory' or 'good' grade in the annual performance assessment reports of at least two of the last three years of the assessment period as specified in Appendix II, Table 1, and has a research score of at least 70 as per Appendix II, Table 2.
- 2. The promotion is recommended by a selection committee constituted in accordance with the UGC Regulations-2018.

#### IV. Associate Professor (Academic Level 13A) to Professor (Academic Level 14) Eligibility:

- 1. An Associate Professor who has completed three years of service in Academic Level 13 A.
- 2. A Ph.D degree in the subject concerned/allied/relevant discipline.
- 3. A minimum of ten research publications in the peer- reviewed or UGC-listed journals out of which three research papers should have been published during the assessment period.
- 4. Evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.
- 5. A minimum of 110 Research Score as per Appendix II, Table 2.

#### **CAS Promotion Criteria:**

A teacher shall be promoted if;

- 1. He/she gets 'satisfactory' or 'good' grade in the annual performance assessment reports of at least two of the last three years of the assessment period, as per Appendix II, Table 1, and at least 110 research score, as per Appendix II, Table 2.
- 2. The promotion is recommended by a selection committee constituted in accordance with these Regulations.

### V. Professor (Academic Level 14) to Senior Professor (Academic Level 15)

A Professor can be promoted to the post of Senior Professor under the CAS. The promotion shall be based on academic achievement, favorable review from three eminent subject -experts who are not of the rank lower than the rank of a Senior Professor or a Professor having at least ten years' of experience. The selection shall be based on 10 best publications during the last 10 years and interaction with a Selection Committee constituted in accordance with the UGC Regulations-2018.

### **Eligibility**:

- 1. Ten years' experience as a Professor.
- 2. A minimum of ten publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and Ph.D. degree has been successfully awarded to two candidates under his/her supervision during the assessment period.

### **General instructions for CAS applicants (for teachers)**

- 1. Before filling the application form, the applicant faculty members are advised to read carefully all the provisions and methods of category wise calculations and assure themselves regarding all the clauses to avoid any kind of technical problem. The information is to be provided in the sequence of years proposed to be assessed; hence the applicants may add the information of all the years in a sequential manner.
- 2. Candidates shall offer themselves for assessment for promotion, if they fulfil the minimum API/Research scores indicated in the respective UGC's amendments / regulations by submitting an application prescribed by the University.
- 3. The applicants are informed to ensure that all the prescribed conditions are fulfilled before they submit their applications. Incomplete applications and without supporting documents, in any respect, will not be processed. Documents relevant to the promotion period only should be attached to avoid unnecessary confusion and the assessment shall be strictly based on the documents enclosed, which are subject to verification.
- 4. UGC's Regulations and subsequent amendments from time to time and endorsed by UGC will be considered for eligibility, filling up the applications, calculating API/Research scores, determining experience, etc.
- 5. Application, submitted after the deadline will summarily be rejected.
- 6. Ensure that each activity is claimed once. Duplicate claim is strictly prohibited.
- 7. The proof substantiating the category I (Teaching activity)shall be attested by the HOD.
- 8. Erroneous / Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected without any intimation to the applicant. Further, the Application shall not to be submitted in piecemeal.
- 9. Refer UGC guidelines 2018 for any other clarifications for filling the CAS application form.
- 10. Applicant shall note the following and take additional care while filling upthe Proforma:

## Para6 of UGC Regulation 2018

- 1. if a candidate applies for promotion on completion of the minimum eligibility period and is successful, the date of promote on will be that of minimum period of eligibility
- 2. if however, the candidates find that he/she fulfills the eligibility conditions at a later date and applies on that date and is successful, his/her promotion will be effected from that date of application fulfilling the eligibility criteria.
- 3. if the candidate does not succeed in the first assessment, he / she shall have to be reassessed only after one year. When such a candidate succeeds in the eventual assessment, his/ her promotions hall be deemed to be one year from the date of rejection.
